Hospitality

Create a warm and welcoming experience for guests and regular attenders at Southside Fellowship.

First Impressions Team

Create a welcoming atmosphere throughout the building on Sunday mornings.

Group Hosts

Welcome and interact with guests at various church events.

Event Team

Create a welcoming environment at church events through decoration and food presentation.

Host/Registration Desk Team

Provide friendly service for our guests checking their children into Fellowship Kids.

Home Host

Provide a meeting place for high school group meetings.

Care and Compassion

Help the under-resourced or those experiencing difficult challenges.

Financial Counseling

Teach, train, and counsel people to help them grow financially and spiritually.

Stephen Ministry

Offer hope, encouragement, and practical support to those dealing with difficult life situations in a one-on-one caring relationship (training provided).

Divorce Care

Facilitate a recovery group for those who have gone through or are going through a divorce (training provided).

Grief Share

Facilitate a group for those who have experienced a loss through death (training provided).

Benevolence Liaison

Serve as a personal contact for those in need of benevolence to gain better understanding of their circumstances.

Shut-In/Hospital Visitation

Offer comfort by visiting those who have limited opportunity for social interaction due to an illness or other circumstance.

Transportation

Help transport those who are unable to drive themselves to appointments, church, the grocery store, etc.

Meal Preparation

Serve by using your culinary skills to prepare dishes or entire meals for people dealing with family crises.

Kids and Teens

Partner with parents to help kids learn about Jesus.

Fellowship Kids Nursery

Provide a warm and loving environment for children ages birth through 24 months.

Fellowship Kids Preschool

Influence kids 2 years old through K5 as you connect with them through Bible-basics, discovery, and fun.

Fellowship Kids Elementary

Impact kids in 1st through 5th grades by introducing them to Jesus, engaging in life-changing relationships, and presenting the Bible in a practical way.

Provide a fun and loving environment for kids 3 and 4 years old by providing exciting opportunities for them to build friendships and learn more about God's Word.

Influence kids in K5 through 2nd grade through interactive, fun activities as they build friendships and learn God's Word.

Impact kids in 3rd through 6th grades by building life-changing friendships and listening as they learn and share God's Word in a fun and exciting environment.
